President's Report	Mike Hanson	 The Executive Team met in December. The following items were discussed. 2024 Budget. OHNA Secretary responsibilities were divided among members of the Executive Team. Email blasts and periodic newsletters may not occur until we have the Secretary position filled. Discussed the possibility of a neighborhood party in 2024. Trying to find volunteers to fill the following open positions: Secretary Garden Tour Chair(s). Annual Newsletter coordinator(s). We have captains for every block. At future meetings, we will try to have special guest speakers to discuss different topics. Recycling Traffic calming. Note from John Barkel, School Principal. The school is doing its best to keep the sidewalks clear. They have a lot of them, and sometimes the snow gets packed down before they get to them making the sidewalks icy
Treasurer's Report	Craig Geers	Ended December with \$8,764.28 balance. Already have dues being paid for 2024. We transferred the remaining newsletter (\$1,400) fund into the general fund. Paid liability insurance. Expenses just about even now have balance of \$8,347.62. Venmo still works! Due to Venmo technical matters, it still goes to Lisa, be she is happy to transfer it over. Did not have a quorum to vote on the budget, but Craig reviewed it. We started the process by looking at the previous year's budget. Hasn't varied that much from last year. Seeking \$8,000 in dues. Other revenue buckets are the same. We are holding newsletter rev at \$3,000 even though we tend to do better. Increase for lamp decorations. may need to increase the amount of decorations, may need storage, and/or installation costs. We increased the community benefit line item and added a new fund to recognize 100-year-old homes. Last year we didn't do block parties or a movie in the park but funded that this year because we want to do those fun events. We also made a decision to buy trees every other year. The budget calls for \$13,000 in revenue and \$11,222 in expenses.
